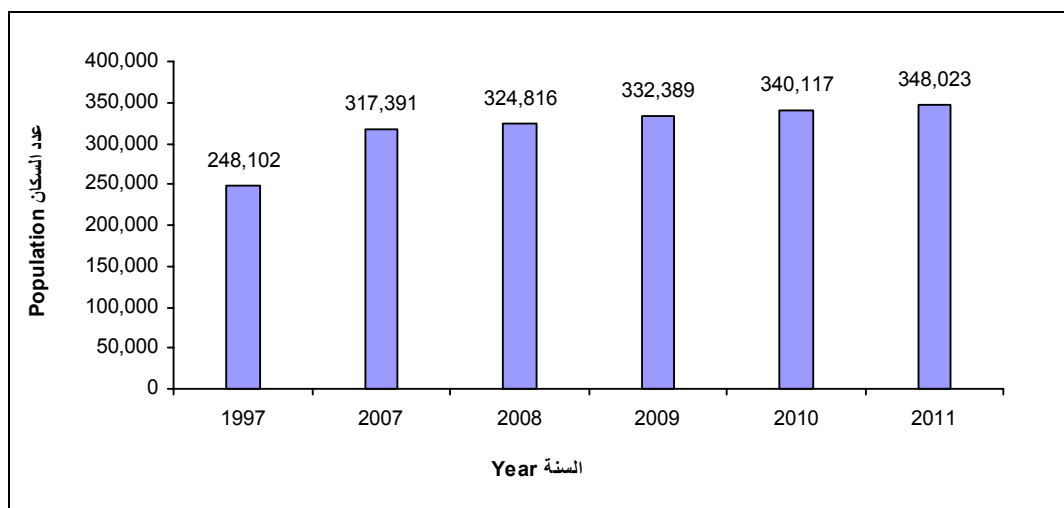

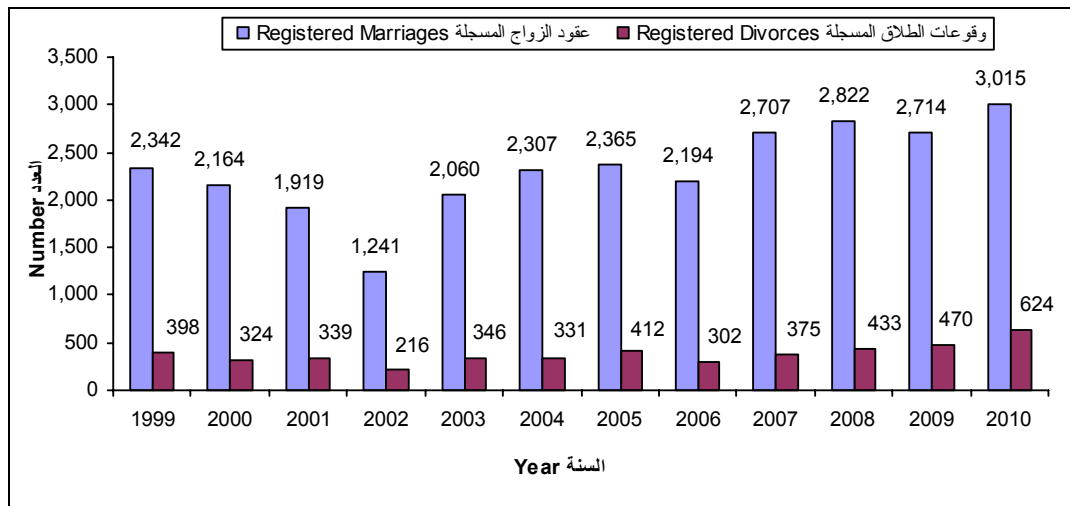

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Nablus Governorate, 1999-2010



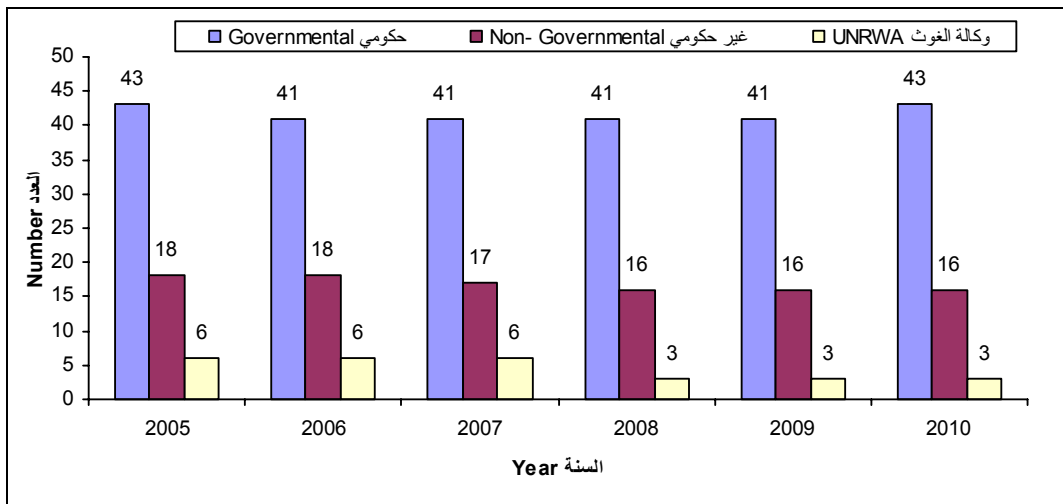

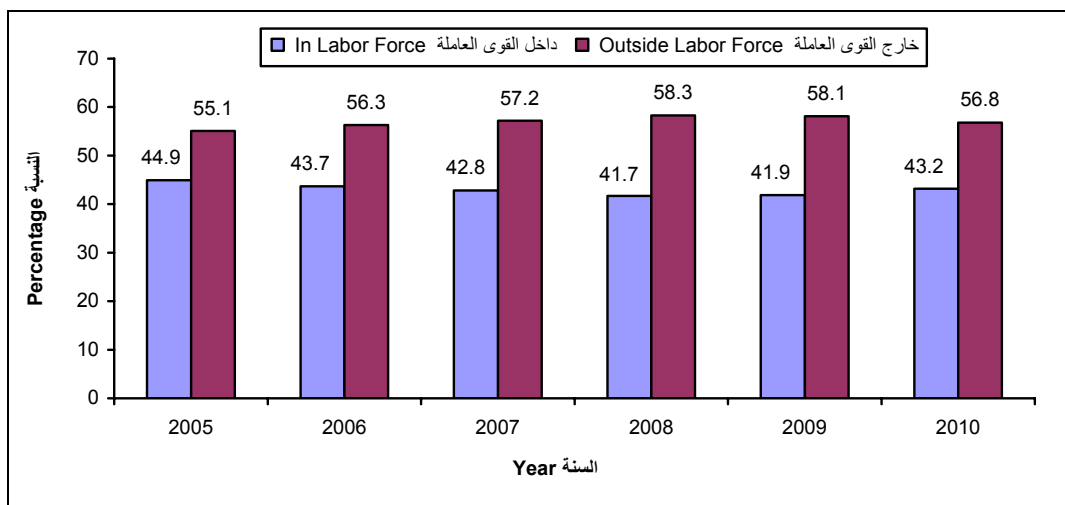

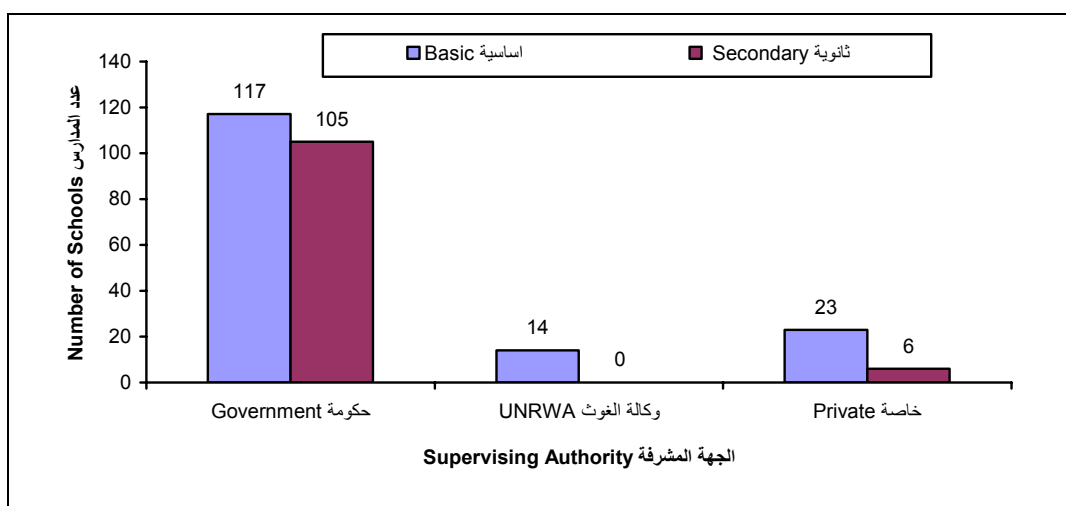

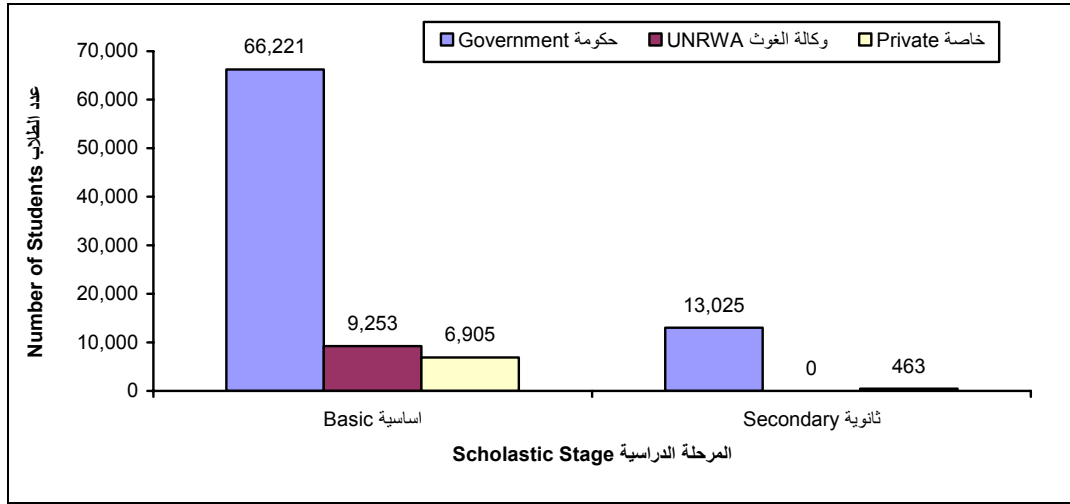

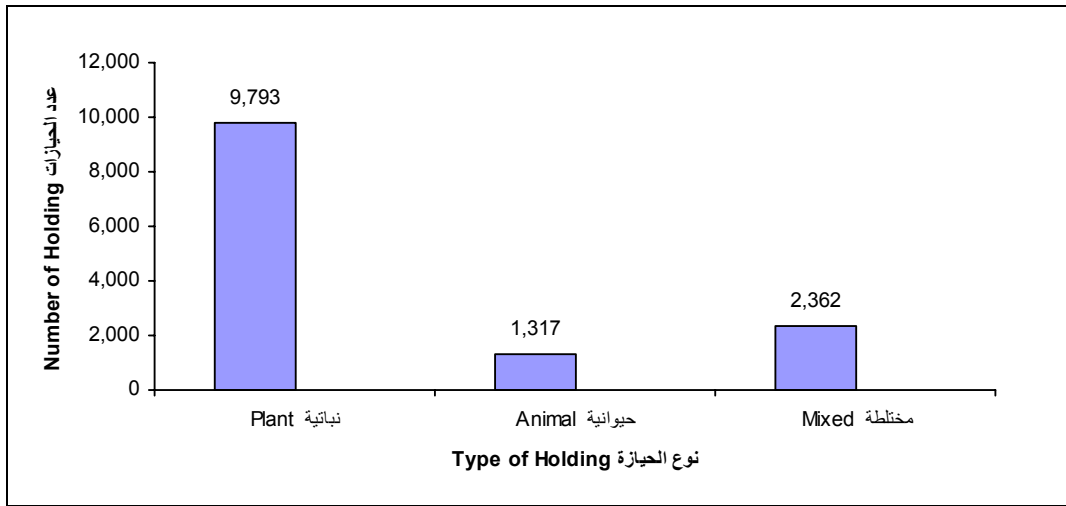

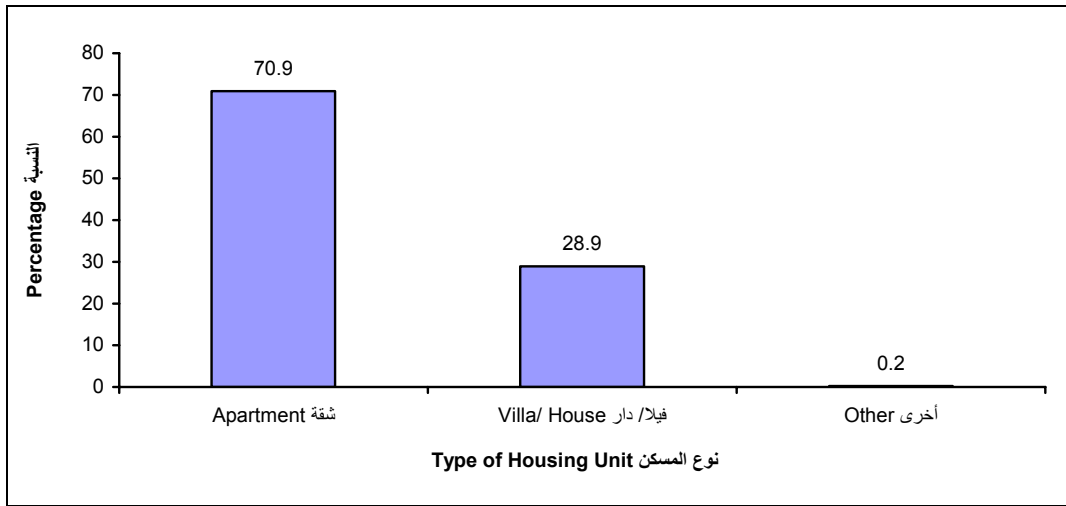

Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households in Nablus Governorate by Type of Housing Unit, 2010



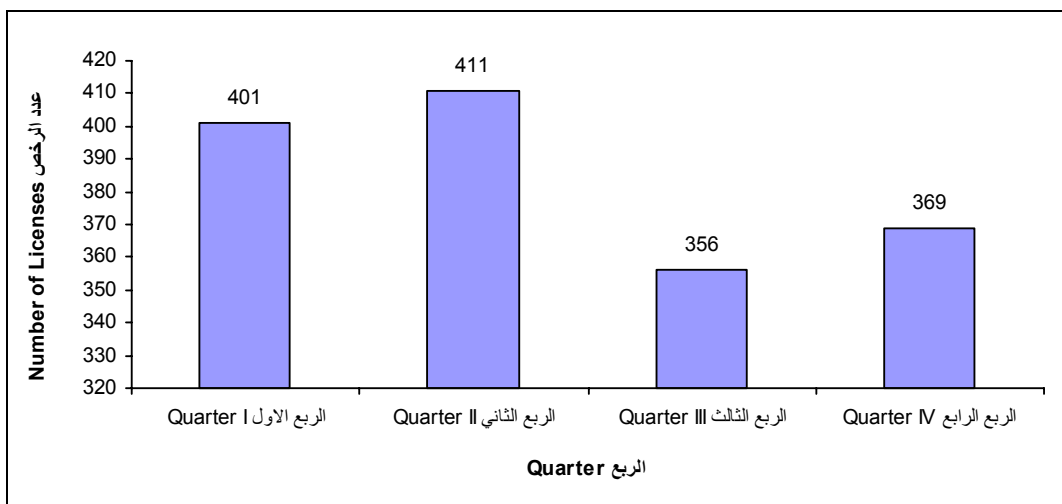

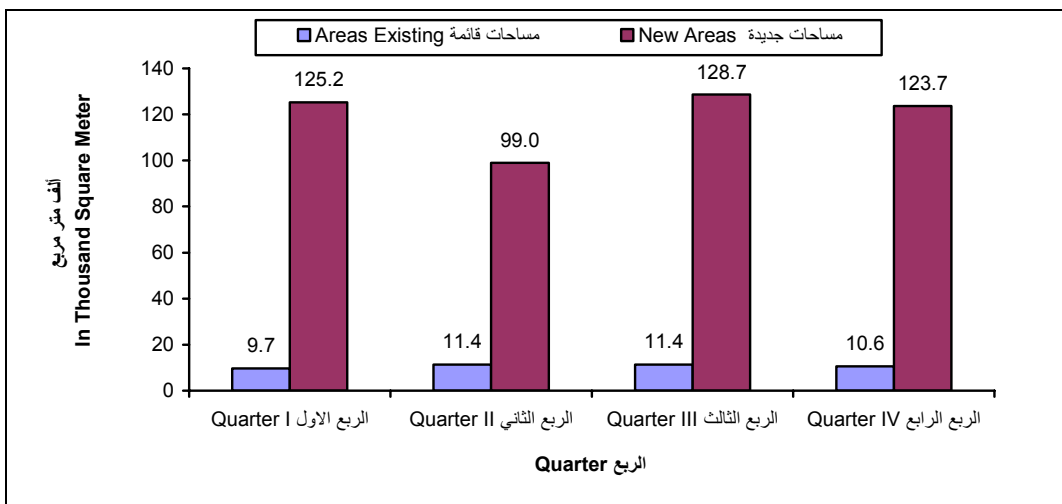
Figure 10: Issued Building Licenses in Nablus Governorate by Quarter,2010

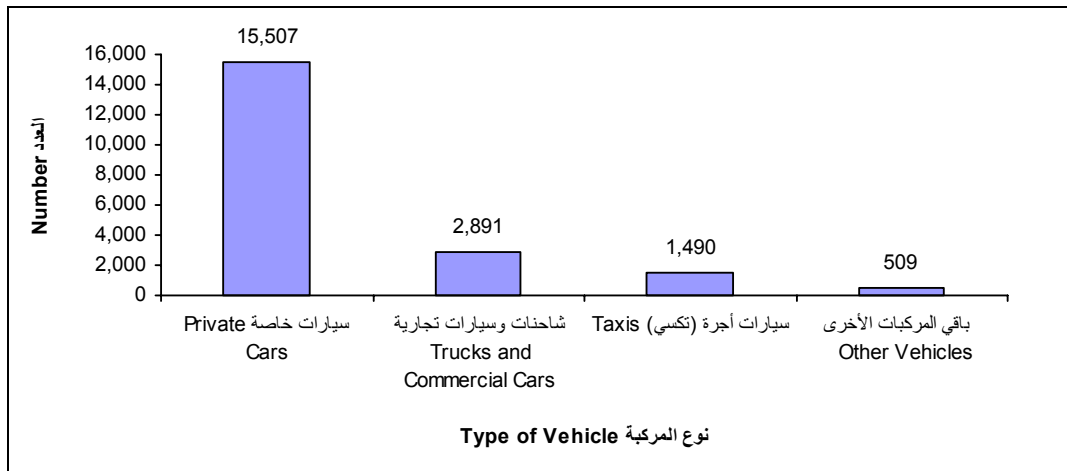

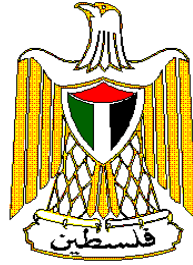

Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Nablus governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Nablus governorate totaled 348,023 person at mid 2011 including 176,099 males and 171,924 females. About 26.3% of the total population of Nablus governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at shariah and church courts during 2010 in Nablus governorate totaled 3,015. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 624.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Nablus governorate totaled 9,539 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 1,024.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Nablus governorate was 6 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 550 with bed occupancy rate of 1.6 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Nablus governorate was 43.2% from total of human power. Unemployed persons constitute about 13.7% of those participating in labor force.
- 11.3% of the individuals are poor in Nablus governorate in 2010.
- There were 265 schools and 128 kindergartens in Nablus governorate in 2009/2010.
- The area of lands in Nablus governorate in 2010 was 605 square kilometers.
- Number of agricultural holdings in Nablus governorate reached 13,472 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Nablus governorate in 2010 totaled 1,537 license for an area of 519.7 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 45 localities in Nablus governorate compared with 19 localities without water network. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 64 localities.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Nablus governorate was 20,397 vehicle.
- The values of imports increased in Nablus and Salfit governorates in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 516.1 million US\$.
- Exports in Nablus and Salfit governorates in 2009 decreased, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 90.7 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus and Salfit governorates in 2009 totaling 425.4 million US\$.
